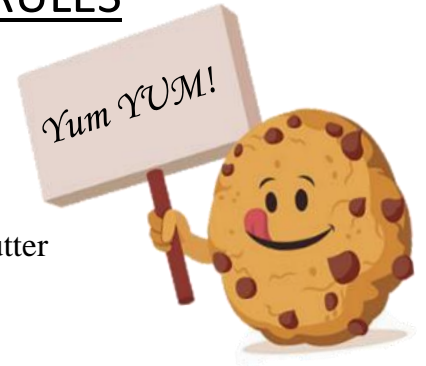

HOMEMADE COOKIE CONTEST RULES



1. Open to bakers of all ages and skill levels. No entry fees.
2. Can only submit 1 entry per participant per category.
3. There will be three categories: Chocolate Chip, Oatmeal and Peanut Butter
4. **NO PRE-MIXES.**
5. Open to all baking methods.
6. Submit 6 cookies on a paper plate then wrap in clear plastic wrap or place in a clear plastic bag.
7. A copy of the recipe must accompany each plate of cookies (Please do not add your name to this or if it's there please cover it up!)
8. **Cookies will be sampled by judges:** Cookies that are uncooked, damaged or unsafe for consumption will be rejected & not judged.
9. A panel of 3 community judges will conduct a blind judging and be judged on the following as it relates to the type of cookie:
 - a. Taste: well-blended, not too much of one spice, no off-flavoring
 - b. Texture: moist, crisp, tender, chewy
 - c. Appearance: color, uniform shape
 - d. Overall Impression/Creativity
10. Entries must be submitted to the 4-H building between **12:30pm - 1:00 PM Saturday July 23, 2022.**
11. A \$25 prize will be awarded for highest score in each category following the conclusion of judging.
12. At the events conclusion, bakers may share the remaining cookies or take them home. Any cookies left will be disposed of by 4pm.
13. By participating in this event, entrants agree to abide by the rules and decisions of the judges, allow their recipes to be viewed by the public and allow organizers to publish photographs of them and their cookies.
